We are in for a great treat for our April 8, 2023, OPLC monthly meeting, as Mark Candee will be talking to us about **Gems of Arizona**, or as he said "at least some of them!" Among them, Mark will feature turquoise, peridot, amethyst, pyrope garnet, and gem silica (the trade name for chrysocolla-in-quartz).

Mark Candee is a goldsmith, gemologist, lecturer, appraiser, and gem and mineral collector. He has field collected in 30-plus U.S. states and on four continents. He served as Assistant Curator and Collection Manager of the University of Arizona Mineral Museum from 2009 to 2014. The photo on the top right is from the TGMS tour Mark Candee guided at the UofA Mineral Museum in 2014 before it was all packed and moved to the new Alfie Norville Gem & Mineral Museum.

Mark has also served as Director, Vice President, and President of the Tucson Gem & Mineral Society (TGMS). Locally he exhibits with his gem and mineral company, Canyon Colors, with his fellow club members at the Annual TGMS Holiday Craft Show in December.







Adjourn at 5:35 pm.


