

We are in for great treat and start of the New Year 2024 at our January 13, 2024, OPLC monthly meeting. Christine and Scott Logan will be presenting **Turquoise** & the Art it Inspires.


The Powerpoint presentation **Turquoise and the Art it Inspires** focuses on an overview of the historic use of turquoise in world cultures, the folklore and traditions surrounding it. It then shifts to the modern sourcing of turquoise and the 'disappearance' of American sources. They will also bring some rare turquoise cabs for show-and-tell.

Christine calls Tucson her hometown. Being raised in the Tanque Verde area and graduating from the University of Arizona, she met Scott, her husband and native Tucsonan, at Rincon High School. She grew up with parents who were avid collectors and dealers of Native American art, jewelry and turquoise cabochons, and their passion is now her passion. American turquoise, both rare and common, has captured Christine's full attention.

Scott graduated with a degree in hydrology from the University of Arizona and had a career in the environmental science consulting industry working on projects for the Department of Defense, the Corps of Engineers, and FEMA, among others. His specialty was hydrogeology and how contaminants moved through water, soil, and rock. It was an excellent precursor to joining his wife in the gemstone world.

Connecting with artists, collectors, dealers and the lapidary community is an ongoing adventure for the two of them.

#### **MINUTES OF JANUARY 2, 2024 OPLC BOARD MEETING**

Present: Victoria Fila presiding, in David Schulte's absence, Dave Richardson, Mark Davidson, Bill Penrose, John Poole, Janet Keisler, Twink Monrad, Donovan Wagner, Ted Rupp, Brian Peterson, Wendy Huber. A quorum was present.

Treasurer's Report – Mark Davidson –For end of 2023. Precise figures are confidential but available to members on request.

Overall, OPLC had a positive cash flow for 2023. 70% of the allocated budget was spent. All labs were positive except Faceting, which had an overrun of \$8.51! Interest income is higher now that banks are paying more interest.

Liability insurance was paid today, Jan 2, and does not appear on this year's statements.

Membership Report – Jan Keisler – There are 187 paid up members for 2024 so far. An annual and initial fee schedule was presented by Jan. It was discussed and some changes incorporated.

Cab Lab – Donovan Wagner – we are changing wheels on January 6, 2024

Silver Lab – John Poole - a new class begins next week

Saw Room – no report

Faceting – Dave Richardson – water supply is nearly installed – a used machine was acquired by Dave

Field Trips – new places for field trips are needed – should ask about locations by asking members

Future Meeting Times – during the day preferred – we can choose a time when Donovan is available on Zoom, his lunch hour perhaps?

Silent Auction – income from 2023 was critical to the club's positive cash position – Danny Harmsen manages it, but needs volunteers to do hands-on work.

TGMS Showcase – David is organizing the case – we have to request samples of work for the cases – paperwork must be sent in by Jan 12

County Fair – let's not take the church this year, the sphere machine attracts more people.

Hob Nob – was very successful last year and we expect the same this year – Dave Richardson has arranged the caterer – admission will be \$18 + a \$2 recommended donation

Budget for 2024 – To be approved at the next membership meeting.

New business – We need new brochures printed up. A printing of 500 will suffice. Phone numbers of some executive and membership members will be included.

The meeting adjourned at 6.30 pm.
