#### May 13, 2023 OPLC speaker - Dr. Art Friedman

#### Minerals & Gems with Unusual Physical & Chemical Properties Part II



We are in for a great treat for our May 13, 2023, OPLC monthly meeting, as our very own member, Dr. Art Friedman, will give Part II on his **Minerals & Gems with Unusual Physical & Chemical Properties** presentation. Art gave his Part 1 presentation exactly one year ago.

While the previous talk centered on unusual optical properties, this lecture will focus on some of the more unusual aspects of mineralogy such as color center formation, piezo- and thermoelectric effects, magnetism and radioactivity. These effects will be illustrated using specimens from his personal collection, acquired over a 62-year period.

Dr. Art Friedman is a native of Philadelphia, PA, and received a B.S. degree in biological sciences and an M.S. degree in biochemistry from Drexel Institute of Technology. Following 35 years of employment as a research and development scientist and manager with 16 U.S. Patents and 20 publications, he left industry and taught general chemistry, biochemistry, instrumental analysis and organic chemistry at the college level. Prior to retirement, Art also spent 12 years teaching AP biology, AP chemistry and honors physics at several Chicago-area high schools.

Dr. Friedman promises this to be an exciting presentation, as he will demonstrate some little used tests which anyone can do at home that can aid in the identification of mineral specimens and gemstones.







Board meeting adjourned at 6:20 pm.


