

SEPTEMBER 13, 2025, OPLC SPEAKER CHUCK GALLAWAY History of Santa Cruz Mining 1540-1946





Minutes of Tuesday, September 2, 2025 OPLC Board Meeting 5:00 pm, W Penrose, wrp0143@comcast.net

Present: Jack McCabe presiding, Bill Penrose, Wayne Klement, Dave Richardson, Janet Keisler, Mark Dragoslovich, Mark Marikos, Wendy Huber, Ken Briggs, David Schulte. A quorum was present.

Treasurer Position – After lengthy discussion, the Board consensus was to investigate bookkeepers with experience in working with nonprofits like OPLC. We do not have an actual job description for the Treasurer position, which has expanded over the years to include tasks that an elected volunteer should not be obliged to do. This requirement should be announced at the upcoming membership meeting. David Schulte has volunteered to take over the job of tracking the shop cards, one of our major sources of income.

Treasurer Report – Same as last month. We still do not have a permanent treasurer, and Jack is carrying out essential tasks for now. The Board is investigating alternatives.

Membership – currently 449 members in good standing

Lab Reports –

Silver lab – No report. (Secretary note: no issues in the lab) Saw room – No report.

Cabbing lab – Ken Briggs and David Schulte – Some repairs and upgrades are needed in the cab lab. There are corroded trays and hoods on about ten of the machines, and they should be replaced. Consensus is that they can be replaced from the current budget. Backsplashes should be installed behind the machines. The cab lab also needs painting, which will require volunteers from the membership. Casting lab – Mark Draslodovich – the lab is operating smoothly Faceting lab – Four machines have been repaired by the manufacturer and two more are being sent today for an eventual total of ten.

Field Trips – In the absence of a coordinator, Jack will contact Rod Trevino about piggybacking on some of the Sierra Club's trips. (Secretary note: Mo Garrett is planning a field trip to the Wickenburg area in October or November.)

Nominating Committee – Janet Keisler has volunteered to chair the Nominating Committee for this year.

Tailgate Sale - Dave Richardson will open up at 7 am.

Outreach Projects – Mark Draslodovich brought the rest of the board up to date on the project with 100 Men.

Lab Cleanup – David Schulte suggested scheduling a club cleanup day before the Christmas Party.




